


# Falling Madly in With Jesus

Ephesians 3:14-19


† The end goal, we're a **mature, complete person, filled with the fullness of Christ.**

## II. Relying on the Power of Prayer




God has to do that supernaturally by the power of His Holy Spirit; and when He does that, you just get it.
